Notice of Race

PISC Autumn Regatta 2022

Saturday 9th October 2022 – Sunday 9th October 2022

The notation **[NP]** in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes Racing Rules of Sailing 60.1(a).

1 Rules

- 1.1 **[DP]** Protocols relating to Covid-19 may be published at any time and will state if they have the status of a rule.
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in 2021–2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (“RRS”).
- 1.3 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

2 [NP] [DP] Advertising

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3 Venue

- 3.1 Agios Georgios harbour, Pegia, Paphos, Cyprus.

4 Series

- 4.1 The regatta consists of a single series.

5 Eligibility and Entry

- 5.1 The regatta is open to any sailing dinghy measuring less than seven metres overall length whose most recent Portsmouth Yardstick Number published by the Royal Yachting Association is equal to or less than 1200.
- 5.2 Competitors entering a boat that is owned by the Organising Authority must be temporary or full members of PISC.
- 5.3 Competitors who are not members of PISC may be required to show compliance with RRS 75 at registration.
- 5.4 Helms under the age of 18 on Sunday 9th October 2022 must be qualified to CYSAF level 3 or recognised equivalent.
- 5.5 The maximum number of boats is limited to thirty (30). Should this number be exceeded, eligible boats may be accepted in chronological order of registration at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

6 Registration

- 6.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing the form in Attachment A and presenting it at the registration desk during the times allowed for registration in section 9.
- 6.2 Any helm or crew under the age of 18 will be required to present a signed Parent/Guardian Consent and Supervision Form, as in Attachment B, at registration. All such helms and crew must be supervised at all times on-shore by a responsible adult (parent or guardian) who will be solely responsible for their safety and welfare.
- 6.3 The Organising Authority does not accept responsibility for the safety or welfare of any competitor, see NoR 18 and NoR 19.
- 6.4 The registration desk will be located by the café at Agios Georgios beach. Competitors are asked to aid the Organising Authority by advising of their intention to register via email to rsc.pisc@gmail.com.

7 Fees

- 7.1 7.1 Registration fee per boat is:

8 Classes

- 8.1 There will be Kestrel, Laser and Wayfarer one design classes, and a General Handicap class.
- 8.2 Any boats in a one design class with less than five (5) entered boats will compete in the General Handicap class.

9 Schedule

- 9.1 On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1530.
- 9.2 A prize giving ceremony will be held as soon as practicable after the last race.

10 Sailing Instructions

- 10.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration, and may also be posted prior to the regatta at www.pisc.com.cy/on-the-water/regatta-information.

11 Scoring

- 11.1 Two (2) races will be required to constitute a series.
- 11.2 When fewer than five (5) series races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five (5) races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.3 Where multiple classes are competing against each other the most recent Portsmouth Yardstick number published by the Royal Yachting Association or relevant Class Association, in the unfettered discretion of the Organising Authority, will be used to calculate corrected time.

12 [NP] [DP] Berthing of dinghies

- 12.1 Dinghies shall keep to their allocated places when ashore as directed by the Beach Master.
- 12.2 Dinghy trolleys must be tagged with a sail number and other identifying information.

13 Prizes

13.1 Prizes will be awarded to helm and crew to third place in each class.

13.2 The Peter Dicker Trophy will be awarded to the highest placed boat on corrected time that is helmed by a full PISC member.

13.3 Additional trophies may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

14 Rights to use name and likeness

14.1 Competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

15 Safety Regulations

15.1 Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times whilst launching and recovering on the slipway and while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

16 Cancellation

16.1 The Organising Authority may cancel or postpone the regatta at any stage in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise.

17 Misconduct

17.1 The Organising Authority may exclude anyone from the regatta at any time and evict anyone who refuses to comply with this Notice of Race (NoR) or the Sailing Instructions or who misconducts themselves in any way or who causes damage or annoyance to other persons.

18 Risk Statement

18.1 RRS 4 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the regatta, you agree and acknowledge that:

18.1.1 you are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of yourself, your crew and your boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the regatta;

18.1.2 you are responsible for the safety of yourself, your crew, your boat and your property whether afloat or ashore;

18.1.3 you accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own actions or omissions;

18.1.4 your boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the regatta and you are fit to participate;

18.1.5 the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the Organising Authority does not relieve you of your own responsibilities;

18.1.6 the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

18.1.7 it is your responsibility to familiarise yourself with any risks specific to this venue or this regatta referred to in the Sailing Instructions and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue;

18.1.8 you will not participate in the regatta if under the undue influence of alcohol, drugs or if otherwise unfit to participate.

19 Disclaimer of Liability

19.1 You hereby agree and acknowledge that you take part in the regatta of your own free will and at your own risk and that the Organising Authority shall not be nor be deemed to be responsible or liable whether in contract or in tort or under any statute for any personal injury (including illness) which may be suffered by you or any damage sustained to your personal property during the regatta or any other loss or damage suffered by you as a result of your participation in the regatta.

20 Insurance

20.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover.
