PISC Pico Challenge 2022

Saturday 8th October 2021 – Sunday 9th October 2022

Rules

- The Pico Challenge will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- Racing rules may be changed as follows: 33, 35, A4, A5, 60.1(a), 61.1(a) (2), 62.1(a). The changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.

Advertising [DP]

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

Venue

3.1 Agios Georgios harbour, Pegia, Paphos, Cyprus.

Series

4.1 The Pico Challenge consists of a single series.

Eligibility and Entry

- Helms must be full members of Paphos International Sailing Club. Crews must be full or temporary members of Paphos International Sailing Club.
- The Pico Challenge is open to Pico class sailing dinghies.
- Helms under the age of 18 on Sunday 10 October 2021 must be qualified to CYSAF level 3 or recognised equivalent.
- The maximum number of boats is limited to six (6). Should this number be exceeded, eligible boats may be accepted in chronological order of

registration at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

Registration

- Eligible boats may enter by completing the form in Attachment A and presenting it at the registration desk during the times allowed for registration in section 9.
- Any helm or crew under the age of 18 will be required to present a signed Parent/Guardian Consent and Supervision Form, as in Attachment B, at registration. All such helms and crew must be supervised at all times on-shore by a responsible adult (parent or guardian) who will be solely responsible for their safety and welfare.
- The Organising Authority does not accept responsibility for the safety or welfare of any competitor, see NoR 18 and NoR 19.
- The registration desk will be located by the café at Agios Georgios beach.

Fees

7.1 Registration fee per boat is: €15. For Pisc owned boats the rental fee of €10 applies.

The schedule may be changed by the Sailing Instructions

- **Sailing Instructions**
 - The sailing instructions will be available at registration, and may also be posted prior to the regatta at www.pisc.com.cy/on-the-water/regatta-information.
- **Scoring**
 - Two (2) races will be required to constitute a series.
 - When fewer than five (5) series races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five (5) or more races have been completed a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- **Berthing of dinghies [DP]**
 - Dinghies shall keep to their allocated places when ashore as directed by the Beach Master.

- Dinghy trolleys must be tagged with a sail number and other identifying information.
- **Prizes**
 - Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organising committee.
- **Rights to use name and likeness**
 - Competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.
- **Safety Regulations**
 - Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times whilst launching and recovering on the slipway and while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- **Cancellation**
 - The Organising Authority may cancel or postpone the regatta at any stage in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise.
- **Misconduct**
 - The Organising Authority may exclude anyone from the regatta at any time and evict anyone who refuses to comply with this Notice of Race (NoR) or the Sailing Instructions or who misconducts themselves in any way or who causes damage or annoyance to other persons.
- **Risk Statement**
 - RRS 4 states: “The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.” Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the regatta, you agree and acknowledge that:
 - you are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of yourself, your crew and your boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the regatta;
 - you are responsible for the safety of yourself, your crew, your boat and your property whether afloat or ashore;
 - you accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own actions or omissions;
 - your boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the regatta and you are fit to participate;
 - the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the Organising Authority does not relieve you of your own responsibilities;
 - the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
 - it is your responsibility to familiarise yourself with any risks specific to

this venue or this regatta referred to in the Sailing Instructions and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue;

- you will not participate in the regatta if under the undue influence of alcohol, drugs or if otherwise unfit to participate.
- **Disclaimer of Liability**
 - You hereby agree and acknowledge that you take part in the regatta of your own free will and at your own risk and that the Organising Authority shall not be nor be deemed to be responsible or liable whether in contract or in tort or under any statute for any personal injury (including illness) which may be suffered by you or any damage sustained to your personal property during the regatta or any other loss or damage suffered by you as a result of your participation in the regatta.
- **Insurance**
 - Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover.
